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Privacy and Security Training

University of Colorado IT Security Program Policy

All data and information resources of the SEHD are subject to University of Colorado's IT Secuirty Program policy, APS-6005. Within the policy it describes employee training:

- 1. Supervisors shall ensure that employees are adequately trained to fulfill theirIT security responsibilities. Employees with elevated computing privileges (e.g., server support technicians, user account managers, or webpage administrators) may require additional, specialized training for carrying out theirIT security responsibilities effectively.
- 2. All Universityemployeesincluding associates and other individuals, who require the use of UniversitylTresourcesto perform their duties, shall receive initial training and periodic refresher training relevant to theirlTsecurityresponsibilities.
- 3. Supervisors shall coordinate their localIT security training initiatives with the campus Information Security Officer.
